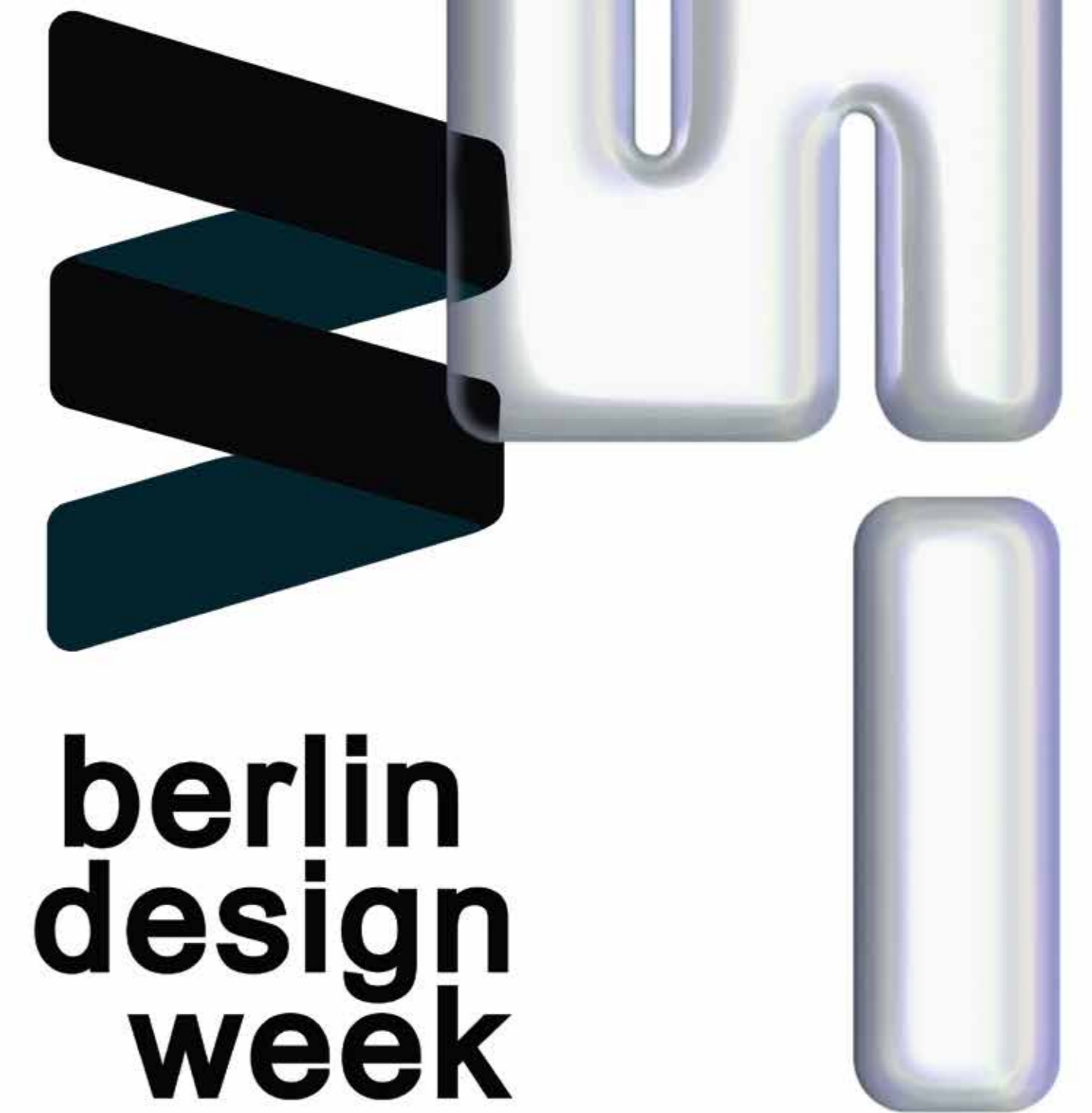
ABOUT BERLIN DESIGN WEEK
BERLIN DESIGN WEEK is an annual festival that highlights and celebrates the diversity of design in Berlin and beyond. It offers a platform for designers, companies and organisations to present and discuss the latest trends and innovations in the field of design. The main location of BERLIN DESIGN WEEK 2024 is the Peter-Behrens-Bau in Oberschöneweide. The historic building is part of the BE-U | Behrens-Ufer project, which, in the coming years, will be transformed into a sustainable urban district unlike any other in the world.
